To complete each box you must have read something unique. For example, if you read Jane Austen's *Pride and Prejudice* you can use it for the 'A classic' box or 'A book written by a female author' box, but not both.

To prove that you have read something you need to provide evidence of this to your English teacher, tutor/Housemaster, the library staff, Mr Braidwood or Mr Copley. This evidence can be a short book report or a video. This will include a brief overview of the book and what you enjoyed/learnt from it.
